



Available Job Opportunity: Pipeline Project Manager

Full-time role in Allen, TX, with some travel required.

CapturePoint currently operates 270 miles of CO₂ pipelines and expects to significantly expand our Carbon Capture and Sequestration (CCS) pipeline network in the next few years. We are seeking an experienced Pipeline Project Manager to support the company with our new CCS pipeline and development projects. The ideal candidate will have 10+ years of experience in project management and construction of regulated pipelines; a thorough knowledge of DOT, OSHA and PHMSA regulations; and be capable of leading large scale complex projects.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead and manage EPC pipeline projects as directed by the leadership team
- Manage all phases of large-scale pipeline construction projects, from pre-development planning to final construction and commissioning
- Lead pipeline development planning including preliminary routing, route optimization, desktop reviews, environmental assessments and constructability
- Provide budgetary costs and schedule for preliminary pipeline projects
- Direct project controls and supply chain to ensure project schedule and budget while tracking progress and adjusting plans as needed to meet project expectations.
- Manage all engineering and design to ensure the integrity of the pipeline asset
- Integrate with the land department for all survey work and ROW acquisitions
- Provide project execution strategies and assist in key decision making to construct cost effective projects
- Manage all subcontractor performance, scheduling, contract compliance, and quality assurance including construction management and execution teams
- Ability to implement pipeline safety and risk mitigation within the project
- Manage potential environmental and cultural impacts throughout the lifecycle of the project

Specialized Knowledge Requirements:

- Familiarity with ASME, NACE, API, and ASTM and other specifications, standards, and recommended practices typical in the hazardous liquid transportation industry
- Working knowledge of applicable regulations and agencies such as FERC, PHMSA, DOT, OSHA, and state regulatory counterparts
- Familiarity with DOE NEPA requirements for pipeline projects
- Good understanding of environmental and cultural impacts

- Understand pipeline safety and risk mitigation
- Knowledge of CO2 pipelines, booster stations and custody transfer metering preferred but not required
- Experience working in the midstream or upstream E&P industry
